

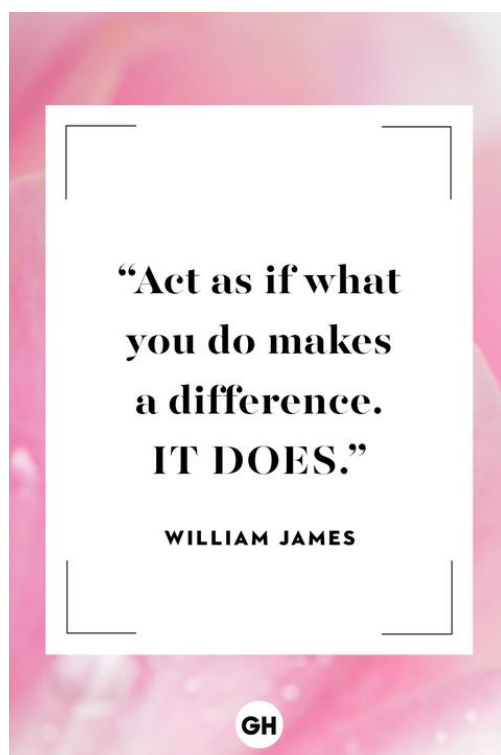

Final 2020 arrangements

We are finally approaching the end of our exams and consequently the end of the 2020 academic year. Please refer to the electronic awards invitation that was sent out on the groups awhile ago.

Intermediate and Senior Phase children will have the opportunity to go through the final exam paper on Monday 30 November and Tuesday 1 December 2020.

Foundation Phase and Pre-school will have their awards on Tuesday 1 December 2020 at 08:00 and should be done by 10:00.

Intermediate Phase and Senior Phase awards will take place on Wednesday 2 December 2020 at 08:00 and should also be done by 10:00.

Unfortunately in keeping with the Covid-19 protocols we cannot allow more than two persons per child at these events and we will also not have any refreshments afterwards. Children may however go home after awards as a treat. Please remember that wearing a mask is mandatory. Sanitizing will also take place at the entrance to the hall.

Going forward, following awards children do not have to come back to school unless they really want to. School will close daily at 12:00 until 3 December 2020.

Our school year for our children will thus officially end at 10:00 on Friday 4 December 2020. Aftercare will continue until Tuesday 15 December 2020. Any learner, normally not in Aftercare, is welcome to attend the holiday school at a cost of R500 from 7 – 15 December 2020.

Reports may be collected between 07:00 and 09:00 on Tuesday 8 December 2020. Please note that, God willing, school will re-open Thursday 14 January 2021.
